

Examples of 155 Orphan Students Sponsored Through Secondary Boarding School



L: Francine graduated HS 2014. She is married and works as field agent for the Water Company.
R: Henriette graduated HS 2016 and sells phone services



L: Jean Paul graduated HS 2012, is married and teaches primary school.
R: Francine graduated HS 2011, won scholarship to university. She is married and teaches at Teachers College.



All of these young graduates, now in their twenties, are orphans of fathers or of both parents. Tuition free primary school was as far as they would ever have gone without a sponsor for 3 years of secondary boarding. In this remote rural district there were very few sponsors until we started in 2009. With the outstanding education and socialization of the boarding schools they exceed all expectations, achieving dreams of sustainable life beyond poverty and disappointment.



L: Jean graduated HS 2014, became teacher and now Prefect of Students, ie their parent away from home.
R: Danny had option of univ. but decided to work on a road gang instead so to support his mom who has AIDS.



Tuition in boarding school cost \$300 a year. Often we also bought the uniforms, notebooks, soap and toothpaste and other requirements. Most came from dirt floor adobe houses where they ate one meal a day. School provided 3 meals, cement floors, electricity, clean water, education, moral guidance, camaraderie and the confidence lift their families out of poverty and their country to shared prosperity.
